News about our association's work

We have often been asked for training on the subject of prevention. At schools where reading takes place in the afternoon during the OGS hours and where the OGS has a Catholic provider, proof of training in prevention is sometimes required. This is the case at the LyngsbergSchule.

Our tip: Register in time! The events are very popular and therefore quickly booked out.

During the summer holidays, the Stadtmuseum Bonn in cooperation with the Internationales Begegnungszentrum Bonn and Kultur verbindet e.V. offers a two-week holiday event. This "time travel through Bonn" will take place in the last two weeks of July. Every day, the children discover a different historical place in Bonn. They can creatively and imaginatively implement their impressions and ideas of what they have seen with their own small stop-motion films. We will send you detailed information soon.

For all those who still need small pots for herbs or flowering plants for the balcony: Have a look at the picture in the attachment to this newsletter! Such pretty pots can be made very quickly with empty cans.

- With a hammer and nail punch several holes in the bottom of the can and also a hole about two centimeters below the upper edge.

- Now paint the cans (preferably using waterproof paint suitable for metal surfaces).
- Fill the can with soil, then plant or sow a flower or herbs and water them.

- Pull a string or better a metal wire through the upper hole and attach the vessel to the balcony grille. But please in such a way that the irrigation water does not drip on the head of the neighbour downstairs! If you water your plants too much, the water will drain through the holes in the bottom of the can.
