Dear friends of Kultur verbindet e.V.,

In 1995, UNESCO declared April 23 as "World Book Day".

The idea for this world day was the Catalan custom of giving roses and books on the name day of the popular saint St. George. And April 23 is also the anniversary of the death of two famous writers: Miguel de Cervantes and William Shakespeare.

On World Book Day, the focus is on books, reading and the rights of writers.

The reading mentors of Kultur verbinden e.V. work every day towards the goal of getting children excited about books and reading. This is often tedious. Especially for children who have problems with reading, letters and text comprehension, reading is exhausting, difficult and therefore anything but enjoyable.

These children can be inspired to read when books are read to them, when talking about the texts and the content, when they can develop their own ideas and invent their own fantasy stories. Tips for reading and leisure

From **March 28th to June 30th**, the Bouncy Castle Town will be set up directly at the Pützchen motorway exit (Siegburger Str. 187). It is open from Wednesday to Friday from 2.30 pm to 6 pm, on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays from 12 pm to 6 pm. In case of rainy weather, the park remains closed. Numerous bouncy castles invite children and adults to play and romp. Admission is \notin 10 for children, \notin 4 for adults and \notin 25 for families (2 adults and 2 children).

Rainy weather - boredom??? - Make yourself a sock octopus

Do you have an old sock left? Definitely, because the other one has certainly disappeared into the washing machine socks universe. In addition to the sock, you will also need a thread, filling wool, some fabric or wobbly eyes, scissors and glue.

Here's how to make your octopus:

- Put the stuffing wool into the tip of the sock until you have a firm ball in the front. Alternatively, you can use rice.

- Tie the sock tightly under the filling with the thread. It is best to wrap the thread around the sock a few times and make a double knot. This is the octopus head.

- Glue two eyes to the head (either ready-made wobbly eyes or you cut out two eyes from fabric.

- Cut the open part of the sock into 8 strips about 1.5 cm wide. Stretch each strip once firmly. Then it will curl up.

Done! If you fill the head with rice, you can also use your octopus as a catch ball or juggle with it. Enjoy!
